Successful Placements in Graduate School and the Workplace

Class of 2009

- Seven chemistry majors
- 57% continued their chemistry careers in graduate studies at Arcadia University, The University of Scranton, Lehigh University, and the Delft University of Technology in Netherlands
- 33% continued their careers as professional chemists and as high school teachers

Class of 2008

- Nine chemistry majors
- 44% continued their chemistry careers in graduate studies at the College of William and Mary, Wilkes University, and Marywood University
- 33% continued their careers as professional chemists at Sanofi Pasteur, the vaccines division of Sanofi-Aventis Group; and AmeriCorps

Class of 2007

- Ten chemistry majors
- 50% continued their chemistry careers in graduate studies at Cornell University, Syracuse University College of Law, The University of Scranton, and The Pennsylvania State University
