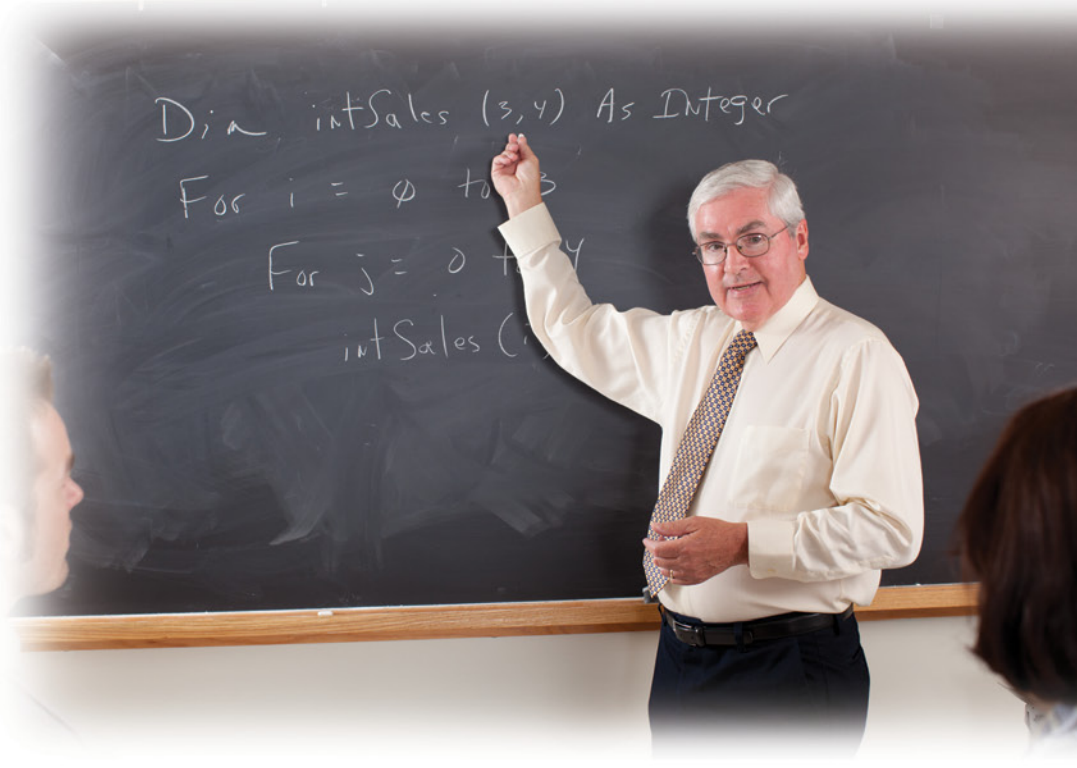
Computers and Information Systems
